

European Housing Forum

The European Housing Forum is a grouping of organisations with specific interests in the field of housing, which meet periodically to discuss matters of mutual concern.

Members are, apart from CECODHAS: FEANTSA (the European federation of national organisations working with the homeless), EUROCITIES (Network of major European Cities), COFACE (Committee of Family organisations in the EU), ENHR (European Network of Housing Research), UEPC (European Union of Developers and House Builders), European Observatory for Social Housing, ECSC (European Society of Chartered Surveyors), IUT (International Union of Tenants) and Habitat et Francophonie

There is no formal constitution for the group , though a set of practical procedures has been agreed to enable meetings to function efficiently, membership admission to be agreed and secretarial services to be provided.

The Forum's principal objectives are:

- the exchange of information between its members;
- the identification of topics for discussion;
- joint initiatives towards European institutions on specific issues agreed upon unanimously;
- the demonstration of the significance of the housing sector at all levels.
